

The clinical physiology course consists of 30 hours of classes. The classes are carried out by the course schedule and learning outcomes included in the syllabus. The whole course consists of **9 practical classes** conducted in three blocks, consisting of 3 meetings. The first and second meetings last three academic hours (**135 min**), and the third last four academic hours (**180 min**).

The clinical physiology course does not end with an exam but a pass without a grade.

ABSENCES

- 1/ Students' attendance at all classes is mandatory and monitored.
- 2/ Students who, due to life circumstances, will not be present at classes are obliged to excuse themselves and makeup missed classes.
- 3/ The only form of justification for absence resulting from illness or other health reasons is a doctor's note, which must be reported within 7 days to the course caretaker.
- 4/ In the event of other accidental situations, the student must immediately inform the course caretaker about the reason for the absence. The course caretaker decides whether or not an absence that is not the result of illness is justified. He may ask to present a document confirming the absence, e.g. a certificate of representing the University in a sports competition or a death certificate of a family member.
- 5/ The recommended form of making up for the absence is joining another student group immediately after the reason for the absence ceases, but no later than within two weeks. The date for making up classes should be agreed upon with the teacher conducting the classes. If it is impossible to make up classes with another group, the student must immediately contact the teacher and individually set the date and form of obtaining credit for the classes
- 6/ Making up for missed classes may take the form of preparing and presenting a multimedia presentation reporting (orally or in writing) on a scientific article

CREDIT

To obtain credit for Clinical Physiology, the student must:

- 1/ Participate in all classes provided for in the class schedule
- 2/ Demonstrate active participation in all 9 practical classes. Active participation means participating in the discussion or presenting the group's results.

3/ Obtain at least 6 points for each oral presentation

Explanation: To pass the clinical physiology course, it is not enough to score 18 points in total. The student must obtain at least 6 points for each presentation.

4/ A student who does not meet the passing threshold must prepare and individually present a presentation of the entire clinical case discussed during the block.

5/ The student will not receive credit for the course if:

- does not justify absence from classes;
- does not make up for the absence from classes;
- does not meet each presentation's passing threshold (6 points).

All disputable issues or issues not covered by the regulations will be decided by the head of the Department of Physiology.
